

Built to Last

The Emerge Essential is 100% solid state, so unlike PC-based systems there is little to break or wear out. The hardware has a calculated MTBF of more than ten years - well beyond the life of any hard disk or PC. Even better, the Emerge Essential won't grow old because the system continually receives new feature and product enhancements, available as optional software updates that can be installed with a single command.

Security and Remote Accessibility/ Recurring Monthly Revenue Opportunity

Selecting the optional Remote Management Package upgrades the host Emerge system with embedded software code facilitating secure access from a remote client. This add-on code for the Emerge Essential panel works in concert with the optional remote client software, Emerge Navigator, which is typically installed on a server at the dealer/integrator location. This two-part system ensures a secure communication "tunnel" from within the protected network to the corresponding external site.

Like a local web browser, the Remote Management Package allows the Essential to be recognized by a network's firewall as a trusted communication point and is able to communicate bi-directionally with Emerge Navigator without network modifications. This secure tunnel allows authorized remote users to connect to any Emerge system from anywhere. Because of this "inside-out" secure communication method a static public IP address is not needed. The optional Emerge Navigator software provides the interface to manage multiple remote panels, offering dealers an opportunity for recurring remote management revenue.
